Chair of ESID Education Working Party - Job Description

The Educational Working Party of ESID is formed by the Chairperson and other Faculty members of the ESID Summer School. Its goal is to offer educational opportunities regarding Primary Immunodeficiencies to young people starting in the field to enthuse, inform and encourage the next generation of leaders in PID practice and research throughout Europe.

Main tasks and commitments:

- Draw together a working group to deliver ESID Education
- Lead and run the ESID Summer School

The ESID Summer Schools are residential study days including interactive talks and workshops led by leaders in the field intertwined with social interaction in a pleasant setting. Places are offered to applicants selected by the Faculty.

- Develop ESID online education programme (ESID Educational Portal) in collaboration with the ESID Juniors Working Party
- Work closely with the Chair of the ESID Juniors WP's on other ESID education activities
- Lead assessment and allocation of fellowships and travel awards for juniors

The Educational Working Party awards travel grants to the ESID meeting, ESID Summer School and other affiliated meetings.

The Educational Working Party also awards fellowships to ESID junior members for further experience in the field of PID. ESID currently offers short-term fellowships (duration of 1-2 months, EUR 1500 plus up to EUR 500 in travel support) and medium-term fellowships (duration of 3 to 6 months, EUR 1000 per month, plus up to EUR 500 in travel support). There are two application deadlines per year.
