Job Description of PID Care in Development (CID) Working Party (WP) Chair

The ESID PIDCID WP aims to promote equal access to diagnosis, management, and treatment of PIDs in Europe and beyond through liaison with physicians, nurses, patients, and patient advocates.

Main tasks and commitments:

- Establish and coordinate a steering committee of national representatives.
- Support and disseminate ESID activities in less advantaged European countries in terms of diagnosis and treatment.
- Liaise with the J-Project.
- Form close working association with international nursing (INGID) and patient (IPOP) advocate groups.
- Engage at the European level with ERN-RITA, particularly in relation to less well-resourced parts of Europe. Engage with government officials where needed.
- Collect information about access to diagnostic facilities, treatment, health care and reimbursement.
- Work toward the goal that ESID members worldwide have equal access to education and training in the field of PID.
- Encourage ESID to be open and accessible to all members and let their contributions, ideas and suggestions influence our society.
