From 2020 she has been a Consultant Paediatric Immunologist at Great Ormond Street Hospital (GOSH). The Immunology Department provides a diagnostic and treatment service for children with primary and secondary Immunodeficiency disorders, including the development of novel therapies through an active translational research programme. It hosts one of two National Specialist Commissioning Group (NSCG) services for severe primary immunodeficiency disorders in the UK and also receives international referrals for treatment of these disorders.
