ESID SUMMER SCHOOL 2024 TYPE OF SESSIONS

<u>CLINICAL CASES (Problem Based Learning):</u>

The objective is to address real-life situations and use them as a platform to discuss different educational points regarding diagnosis and management of patients with PID. Scheme: Brief introduction to the session and wrap-up by faculty (15-20') Case discussion: 5-10' presentation plus discussion (20' maximum per case).

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FACULTY LECTURES

The objective is to give a short talk (20min) focusing on 1-2 important topics in the management or diagnosis of IEI patients.

MENTORING SESSION

Guided Q&A session with the objective of providing the participants the opportunity of exchanging opinions with experts in regards of professional path, tips on how to pursue a career in smaller centres, exchange of experiences.

COMMUNICATION SKILLS

Objective: To teach students how to communicate with patients in the field of Inborn Errors of Immunity, especially in difficult situations or for difficult life choices. The students need to provide clear information to allow families and patients to make their choice among treatment options.
